In February 2026, Alamance County issued a community survey requesting feedback on funding priorities for the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 budget. We asked you which services should be prioritized or reduced, and we asked you to rank the County’s Strategic Pillars from 1 to 5 in order of importance. We also asked whether you would support or oppose a property tax increase to maintain current service levels. **This is what you said.**

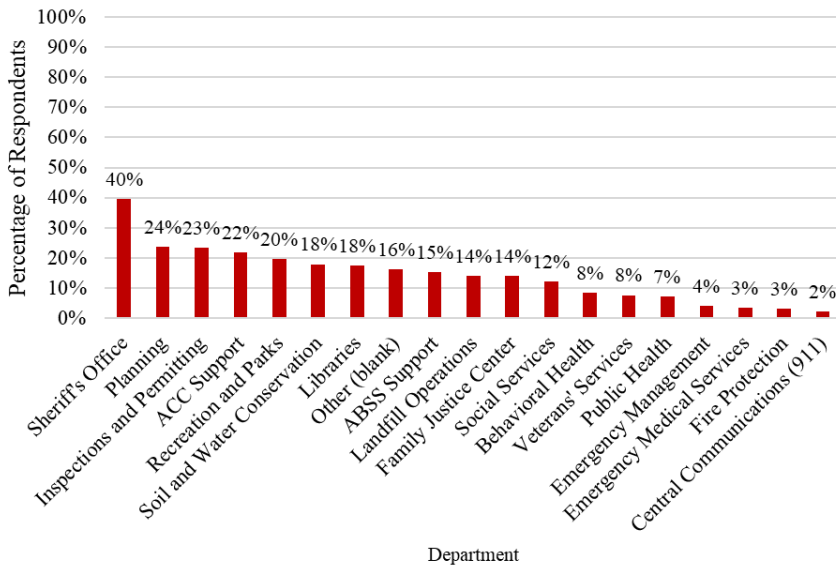
Your top 5 funding priorities are:

5. Libraries

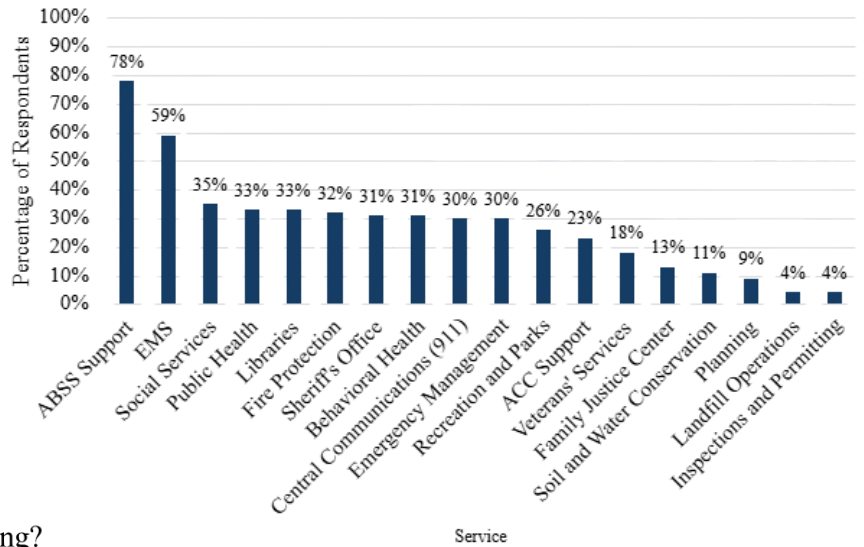


Here is where you said the county should make spending cuts.

What Are Residents' Top Priorities for Funding?

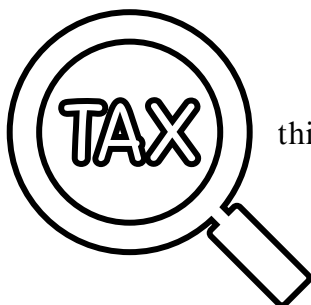


Here is how you ranked the county's Strategic Pillars in order of priority for you:
